

## Brantling Bluegrass Festival Etiquette

Of course we expect everyone to be **RESPECTFUL** of your neighbors and fellow festival attendees.

Please refrain from holding conversations in the concert area while there are performances going on. If you need to talk, please get away from others so that you don't disturb their ability to listen to the great music that most of us are here for.

Please smoke away from others as some people are allergic to smoke and others don't like it.

Please keep your dog(s) at your campsite OR at the perimeter of the concert area away from others. Some are allergic to dogs and some are afraid of them. If you have a dog, please pick up after it. Nobody wants to step in IT. Excessive barking will result in you being asked to remove the dog from the premises.

If you enjoy adult beverages, please make sure you don't have too much. Nobody enjoys being around drunks. Disorderly behavior cannot be tolerated.

Please do NOT move other people's chairs. Common practice at bluegrass festivals is that if a chair is vacant, it can be used by anyone until it's owner returns. If you don't accept that, please remove your chair when you are not sitting in it.

Portapotties are for your use, but please don't throw garbage, etc. in them.

NYS Health Dept rules REQUIRE that campers be at least 10' apart including awnings. We MUST enforce this rule.

Please pick up/clean up after yourself. There are plenty of trash containers around. Cans and bottles can be put in special containers to be recycled.

Jamming is allowed and encouraged. If you don't like it, please locate yourself in an area where you are unlikely to hear it.

Please refrain from using generators except 8 AM until 11 AM and 4 PM until 7 PM. As a courtesy to others, don't run it anymore than necessary. If you need to use a generator more than the allocated hours, we have a special generator area.

Please do NOT leave campfires unattended, and be sure to extinguish them before going to bed.
